

Advanced Programs Exit Survey (2023-2024) Executive Summary Statement

Exit Survey Results (AY 2023–2024 Graduates) – Total 20 graduates completed the Survey.

Quality of Program: High to Moderately High Ratings Overall

- Likelihood to Recommend Program: 95% of respondents indicated they were Extremely Likely (65%) or Likely (30%) to recommend their NAU advanced professional education program to others. This strong endorsement reflects the overall positive impact of the programs on student satisfaction and perception of program value
- Overall Quality of Program: 95% rated the program as Excellent (50%) or Good (45%). These results affirm NAU's commitment to providing high-quality advanced professional education aligned with student expectations.
- **Meaningfulness of Knowledge Gained:** 95% of respondents found the knowledge they gained to be Extremely Meaningful (60%) or Meaningful (35%) for their career preparation. This feedback supports the relevance and rigor of the curriculum in preparing students for professional success
- Effectiveness of Skills Gained: 95% rated the skills gained as Highly Effective (50%) or Effective (45%) for career preparation. The high ratings highlight the program's success in equipping graduates with applicable, career-focused competencies.
- Satisfaction with Preparation for Profession: 95% reported they were Extremely Satisfied (65%) or Satisfied (30%) with their preparation to pursue or continue their profession. These results reflect NAU's ongoing efforts to align program outcomes with professional standards and workforce needs.
- Influence on Professional Practice: 90% indicated that completing the program had a Highly Positive (45%) or Positive (45%) influence on their professional practice. Graduates' feedback confirms that NAU's advanced programs are directly enhancing professional performance and practice
- Influence on Career Path Post-Graduation: 80% reported a Highly Positive (60%) or Positive (20%) influence on their choice to begin or continue a teaching or education professional position. This underscores the important role of NAU's advanced programs in shaping graduates' long-term career trajectories.

Areas for Improvement Identified Through Results

- Advising Received During Program: 25% of respondents reported being Somewhat Satisfied (20%) or Unsatisfied (5%) with the advice they received. While the majority of students reported satisfaction, this area presents an opportunity for NAU to enhance personalized advising and student support
- Tracking Program Requirements: 20% indicated they were Somewhat Satisfied (20%) with how the program kept track of their degree requirements. Improvements in communication and tracking mechanisms could further streamline students' experiences navigating degree milestones.

Teaching or other Education Professional Position upon Graduation

• Of the 17 graduates who responded to Q31 "Do you have a teaching or other education professional position that you will begin or continue upon graduation?" 76% responded yes.
