







# In Memory of




## DEDICATION

## DEAN'S REPORT




Looking back, I imagine this will be considered a difficult year and a year of change. Bill Thompson's death has left an irreplaceable void in the school.




## FORESTRY FIELD DAY

### CONCLAVE

Conclave is the annual meeting of the Association of Western Forestry Clubs. Delegations from forestry schools all over the West, including Oregon State, Colorado State, Montana, Humboldt State, and others, meet at a different location each year for field trips, lectures, and other professional forestry activities. #### **Cut Wood, Not Legs**

Chain saw users now have a proven way to protect their legs against chain saw accidents. Leg-hugging

## TIMBER CHAPS

(also referred to as Chain Saw Chaps) are made of four layers of ballistic nylon quilted between two outer layers of heavy cotton duck. A 3-inch strip of heavy-duty nylon webbing is stitched inside down the center front of each leg to provide extra protection.

The straps that fasten TIMBER CHAPS to wearer's legs are double-stitched to the CHAPS, are adjustable for length and have snap fasteners that attach to D-rings.
