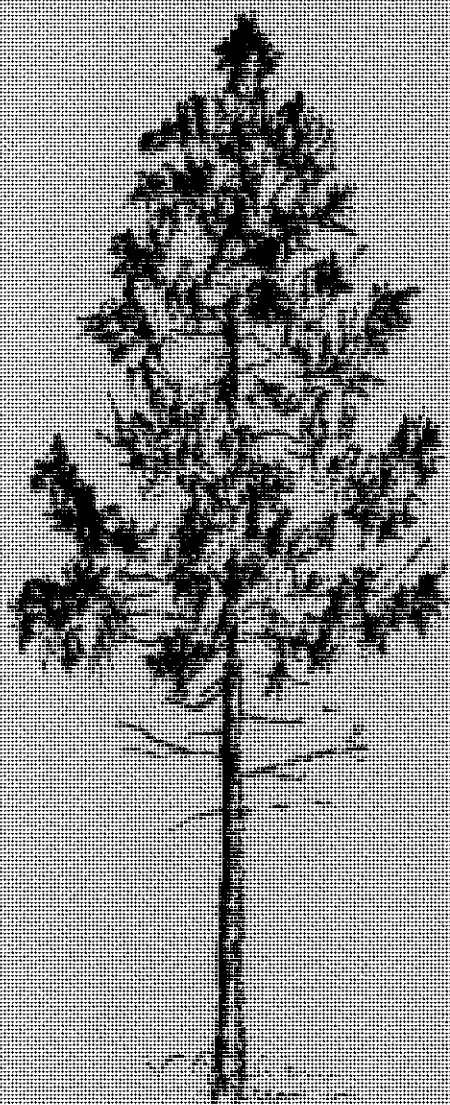

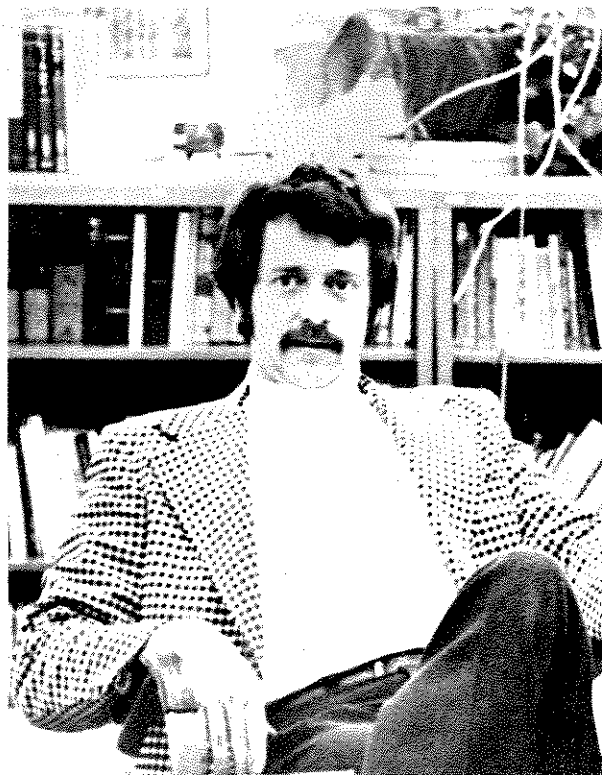


In Memory of

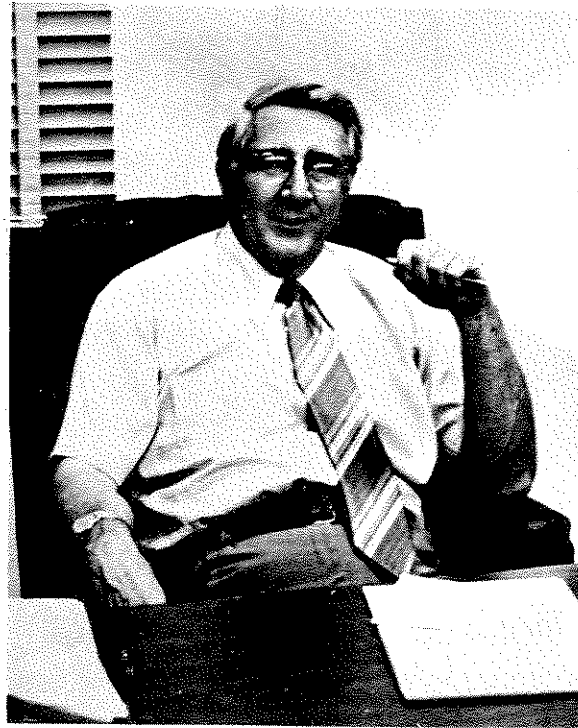


DEDICATION

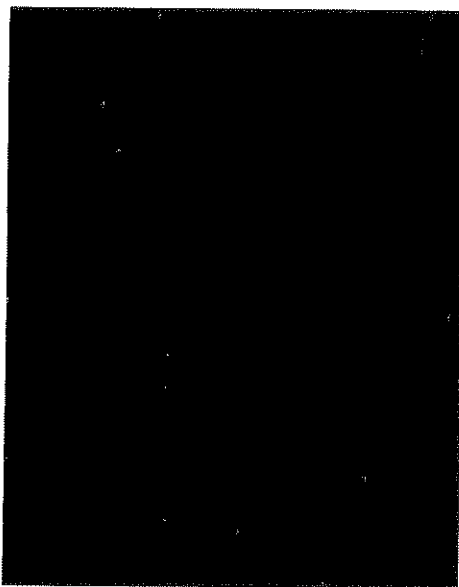
EDITOR'S MESSAGE

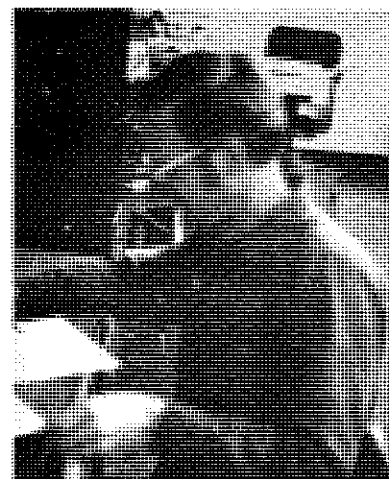
Jean Beaulieu: Got his BA in Psychology from Boston University and is interested in camping, hiking, river running, and motorcycles.



Bob Dyson: Has his BS in Sociology from ASU, interested in music, backpacking, sports, trees, and keeps busy writing his thesis.



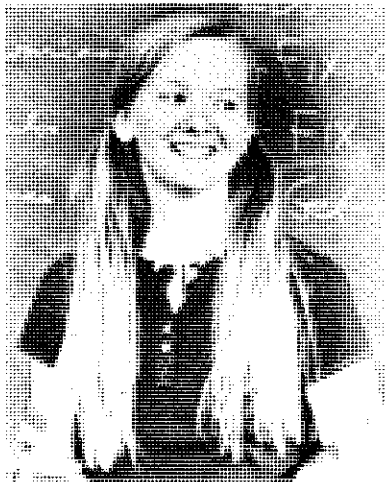
Donald Hoffman: Has a BS in Business Administration from Ithaca College and enjoys his two hounds, working with wood, and environmental planning.



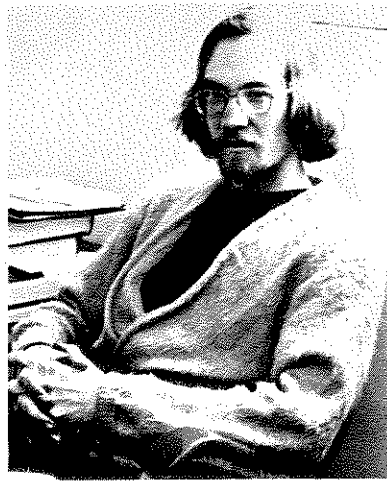

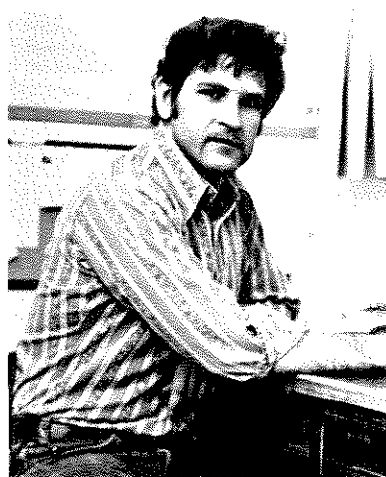
Curt Marsik: Got his BA in advertising art from CSULA, and has worked as a production artist for McCulloch Prop., Inc.
