Are you an IGP student interested in earning a 3rd degree from an international institution??

What does this mean?

IGP students who are enrolling in the below majors are eligible to earn a 3rd degree during their undergraduate career at NAU. The international dual degrees require thoughtful planning to make sure you are on track to earn your three degrees.

FAQs

- How much extra time would this add to my degree path?
 - NONE! By following the specific progression plans, you will be able to earn your international degree during the same amount of time as your original IGP timeline.
- What is the advantage of earning a 3rd degree?
 - Earning an international degree will not only increase your credentials, but it will also open up opportunities for you to internationalize your career path. That includes graduate school, research opportunities, internships, and employment options in both the US and abroad!
- How much extra will it cost me to earn the 3rd degree?
 - NOTHING! As you know, IGP has no program fees and your tuition rate and merit scholarships are locked for all five years. The only additional fees are is the Ed Abroad application fee (\$100) and purchasing additional health insurance for your year abroad.
