☐ [AGEC](#) Requirements: The Arizona General Education Curriculum (AGEC) serves as a key
component of many community college programs in Arizona. While not mandatory, completion
of an AGEC satisfies all General Education requirements at NAU. In some cases, the AGEC is
embedded within Associate degree programs, and many degree-specific courses
simultaneously satisfy AGEC criteria.
