Admission requirements include a "B" or better in SW 220 – Introduction to Social Work or equivalent course, as well as a minimum gpa of 2.25 and 24 credits or more completed or in progress. NAU courses below identified with an asterisk can be completed prior to admission to the BSW program. Please work with your NAU advisor to identify the best time to complete the BSW application.

Admission to the MSW – Advanced Standing requires a gpa of 3.30 in a BSW from a CSWE-accredited program within 5 years of admission *OR* completion within 10 years plus 5 years human service experience.
