- ☐ [Associate of Arts in Elementary Education](#). (An AAEE is not required for admission to NAU's program, but will fill admission and program requirements.)
- ☐ [AGEC](#) Requirements: The Arizona General Education Curriculum (AGEC) is the foundation of a community college education in Arizona. Successfully completing the AGEC means all AGEC courses will transfer as a block to NAU. An AGEC is incorporated into some Associate degrees, and some degree requirements will also fill AGEC requirements.
- ☐ Preprofessional Requirements - *(Multi-use credits, may also fill AGEC or Associate degree requirements.)*
 - ENL 101 and ENL 102 with an average gpa of 3.0 or better.
 - 4 credit Natural Science course that will also satisfy NAU's Scientific Methods course requirement
 - EDU 200 Introduction to Education
 - ECD 135 Survey of Child Development
 - MAT 161 Algebra-based Mathematics for Elementary Teachers I
 - MAT 162 Algebra-based Mathematics for Elementary Teachers IINot required for admission, but highly recommended to be completed at your community college prior to beginning your NAU program.
 - EDU 222 Introduction to Special Education
 - POS 110 and POS 222 **OR** POS 221 and POS 222 to meet US and Arizona Constitution certification requirements.

- A minimum cumulative gpa of 2.5 is required.
- An IVP fingerprint clearance card is required.
