NAU Transfer Plans are a unique tool designed to help guide your academic journey from community college to NAU.

To be completed at Northland Pioneer College:

NAU recommends taking ENL 102 in place of ENG 109. ENL 101 and 102 will also meet an AGECE requirement.

NAU also recommends selecting elective credits with approved Psychology options not completed as a degree requirement; specifically, PSY 240 or PSY 270 (whichever not completed as a core degree requirement) and PSY 250.

☐ [AGECE](#) Requirements: The Arizona General Education Curriculum (AGECE) serves as a key component of many community college programs in Arizona. While not mandatory, completion of an AGECE satisfies all General Education requirements at NAU. In some cases, the AGECE is embedded within Associate degree programs, and many degree-specific courses simultaneously satisfy AGECE criteria.

NAU requires that at least 56 credits of a Bachelor of Science in Psychological Sciences must be completed at NAU. Completing more than 64 transfer credits at NPC may not be optimal. Consult your NPC advisor and your [NAU Transfer Representative](#) to plan your best transfer pathway.

Select twelve credits of upper-division PSY courses. These could include up to 6 units of applied and internship courses (e.g., PSY 408C, PSY 485, PSY 486C)

Select one from the following: PSY 303W, PSY 304W or any Junior-Level Writing Course

Select one additional capstone course from the following: PSY 404C, PSY 408C, PSY 486C, PSY 487C, PSY 490C

Do not duplicate any courses transferred from NPC.

☐ Additional coursework, if required, to complete 56 credits at NAU and 120 credits total.
