Basic Requirements

Liberal Studies (35 hrs) | Diversity Requirement (6 hrs, can include liberal studies courses) Emphasis Requirements (51 hrs, can include 35 hrs for NOCTI exam and/or 20 hrs for occupational experience)

CTE Requirements

All students take core classes in Comprehensive CTE Programs, Community Leadership in CTE, Curriculum Development, Teaching Methods, Research, and complete a capstone course

Students choose 12 credit hours of elective coursework in classes such as Integrated Teaching and Learning, Accident Prevention, and Fieldwork Experience that meet their personal career goals including at least 3 credit hours of instructional technology courses from (Computer Applications in CTE, Presenting Technical Materials, and Multimedia Development
