Pride has been celebrated in various capacities since 1970, but it became a more formally recognized history month in the mid 90s. This year marks the 10 year anniversary of marriage being legalized nationwide for all couples regardless of gender. There will be celebrations statewide. Juneteenth is celebrated on June 19th to commemorate the end of slavery in 1865, making this year the 160th anniversary of this important date in American history. June also marks the official beginning of summer! The first day of summer and the longest day of the year occurs on the summer solstice, which is Friday June 20th. In Arizona, our longest day will be 14 hours and almost 32 minutes of sunshine, almost 5 hours longer than the shortest day of the year. In the most northern areas of the world, you can experience a phenomenon known as the midnight sun, where the sun does not set for about 3 months!
