Enrollment Guidelines

SELECT is a federally funded program sponsored by the Arizona Department of Education and offered by Northern Arizona University, SELECT courses are recommended for special & general education teachers, administrators, related service personnel, para-educators and NAU students interested in learning about students with disabilities.

A Grade = 45 hours; B Grade = 30 hours; C Grade = 15 hours; not completing the course or earning a grade below C = 0 hours
